NEW ADMISSION NOTICE: 3rd May 2019

1. **Issue of Forms** for the New Admission to BA/BCom/BSW 1st Semester will commence **from 8th May 2019 @ Rs. 500/-**. Only limited forms will be issued on a first come, first served basis. Form issuing may be over within 2 weeks.
2. Eligibility norms – **aggregate of 50% minimum for Arts, Commerce & BSW**
3. Forms will be issued, **on first preference, to students who have secured a minimum of 50%** in Class XII (Aggregate without counting Hindi, Geography and Physical Education).
4. **For BA** – if the subject combination in Class XII has HINDI, GEOGRAPHY and PHYSICAL EDUCATION, they should be excluded in the calculation of Percentage. Hence without them, the minimum % should be 50% .
5. Students from Science Streams or Commerce switching over to Arts should have minimum of 50% aggregate.
6. A student of Science/ARTS wanting to do Commerce must have Mathematics or Economics as one of the elective papers in Class XII.
7. **For B.Com** – the Commerce papers proper of Cl. XII should give **minimum of 50%**.
8. Its compulsory to pass for English in Class XII. Failed students of English are not eligible to apply for registration to RGU.
9. **Submission** of duly filled-in forms **from 8th May 2019**
10. Duly filled-in application forms are to be returned to the office on the date specified on the Form.
11. **Interview from 18th May 2019** onwards.
12. **Internet Printout of Class XII mark sheet** should be submitted to the counter at the time of taking Application Form, along with **mobile number** written on the mark sheet.
13. Admission is granted strictly on merit and subject to availability.
14. **Scrutiny of application** will be done after the submission of forms. The selected students will be called for **Personal Interview along with parent/guardian**. The Dates of the interview will be notified on the Notice Board. Failure to report for Interview on the date specified with parents/guardian will render the candidate not eligible for admission. **Admission for New Students will not be done without the accompaniment of Parents/Guardians.**
15. The Names of Students who may need to appear for the Qualifying Test will also be notified on the NOTICE BOARD. The date of the test will be notified along with it. After that the names of the Qualified Students will be put on the Notice Board. The failure to attend the Qualifying Test will automatically lead to the cancellation of the application.
16. Against vacancies, Admissions will be opened to students who have secured less than 50% but above 40% in the Class XII examination. Dates for taking application form, submission and Qualifying Test will be notified later.
17. Those students with Gap in Studies should furnish Gap Certificate.
18. Those with tattoos and unkempt hairdo need not apply. (Hair colour should be black and boys should have trimmed hair)
19. **No Failed Students from Other Colleges under RGU will be accepted in the college.**
